Rules and Regulations

The Downtown Squamish Business Improvement Association first priority is to ensure the safety of all Parade activities, volunteers, participants and committee members, and to ensure that they comply with local health and safety regulations.

For an entry to be accepted into the July 1, 2019 Squamish Canada Day Parade it must conform to the parade's rules and regulations. Application must be submitted on or before the deadline date of June 19, 2019. The DSBIA reserves the right to accept or refuse applications/participation.

1. All entries must be cleared through registration and in position by 9:45am.
2. An approved entry may be refused on parade day should the entry not meet parade guidelines or differ from its approved entry form.
3. No entry may depict anything political, controversial or otherwise offensive. Determination is at the sole discretion of the parade committee.
4. Any entrants of horses and/or live animals require a cleanup person along the parade route.
5. If you do have a motorized vehicle/float there MUST be crowd spotters to ensure the safety of the spectators
6. If your group would like to hand out candy or approved promotional materials, it must be done person-to-person only.
7. NO solicitation for cash or ticket sales along the parade route.
8. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted near any parade entries or along the parade route.
9. All groups must follow organizer's instructions and directions throughout the parade (marshaling and dispersal).
10. Children must be supervised by an adult.
11. Have fun, respect others and show off your red and white!
12. Children and Adults on floats must be secured safely
13. Pace of the parade MUST be adhered to and is set by the RCMP, keep within it please.
